Assigned to 158 Squadron, Wilkinson was shot down on his first and only operation — he called it his "half operation." Bomber Command typically sent the pilot of a new crew on one mission with an experienced pilot and crew. This "second pilot" went along for the ride and the experience. Wilkinson was on his first operation and flying as second pilot on the evening of January 29, 1944, when his Halifax III bomber was hit by flak and crashed near Uithuizen, Holland. All crew members survived and were held as prisoners of war for the duration.





The History of the 15th Army Air Forces Flying Training Detachment covering the period January 1, 1943, to March 1, 1944, states that four Americans were eliminated for academic failure. The History further states that one of the four was sent to Luke Field for completion of his training because he failed only the British Wings Exam after completing the entire course. A/C Paul George Markgraf is the only American cadet eliminated near his expected graduation date; therefore, he must have been the cadet sent to Luke.

### **Course 15 Notes:**

All of the Course 15 American cadets and four British cadets held over from Course 14 began training on March 22, 1943.

All eighteen U.S. Army Air Forces cadets in Course 15 (AAF designation Class 43-B-3) graduated and accepted appointments as second lieutenants in the Army of the United States, and all were assigned to the AAF Air Transport Command, Billy Mitchell Field, Milwaukee, Wisconsin.



#### World War II and Viet Nam

American John Keith Greene of Course 15 was awarded the Bronze Star in Vietnam for his actions as commander of a forward position site that directed B-52 strikes using radar guidance. He retired from the United States Air Force as a lieutenant colonel.

### World War II and Korea

Course 16's Francis Norman "Curly" Satterlee as a First Lieutenant in 1945. Assigned to the China-Burma-India (CBI) theater during WWII, Satterlee flew "The Hump" in C-46 Commandos. He completed wartime service ferrying aircraft to Alaska for transfer to the Russians under the Lend-Lease program.

Satterlee holds the distinction of being the only known Falcon graduate to fly Falcon's advanced trainer, the AT-6, in actual combat. In Korea, he flew hundreds of sorties in T-6Gs (the "A" prefix was dropped in 1947) with 6147th Tactical Control Group. The job of the T-6 pilot was to draw enemy fire and mark enemy concentrations with white phosphorus rockets. Jet fighter-bombers would finish the job. Hit only once by enemy fire, Satterlee recalls that in the jet age "North Korean gunners did not know how to lead a T-6."

Satterlee's medals include the Bronze Star and the Air Medal with two oak leak clusters.
