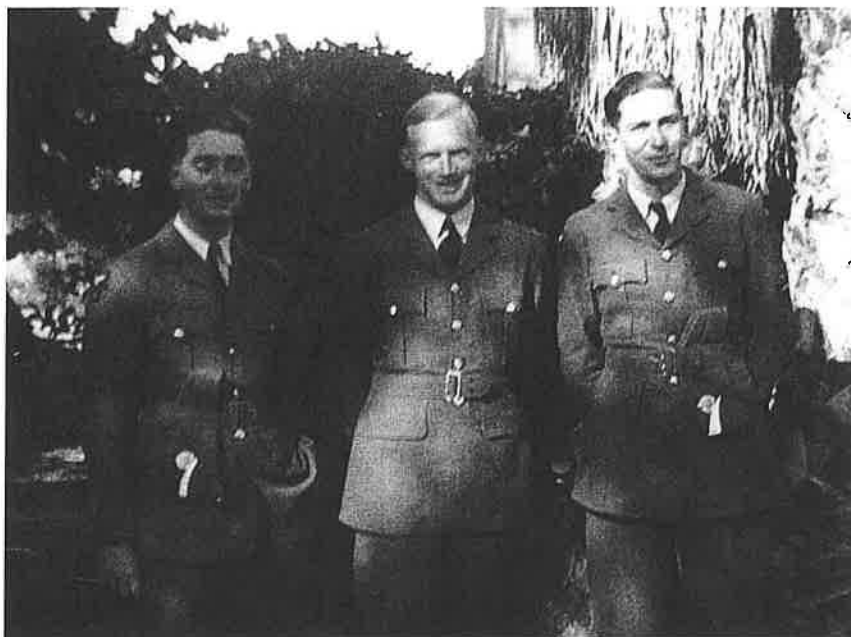

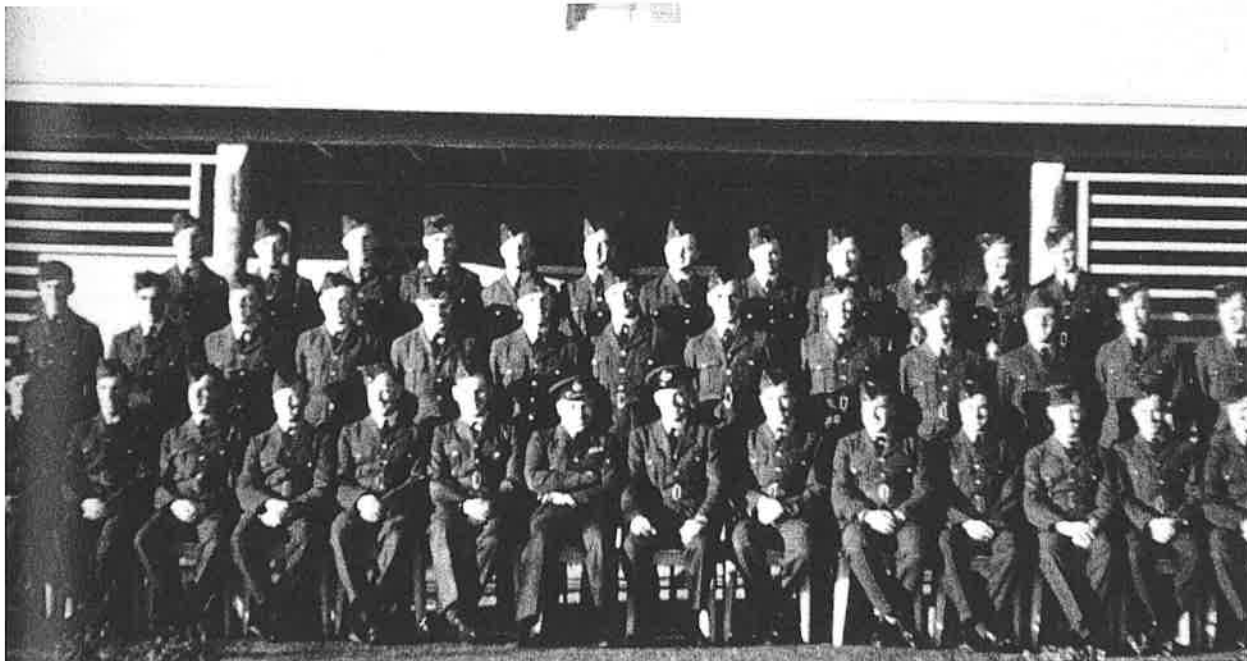

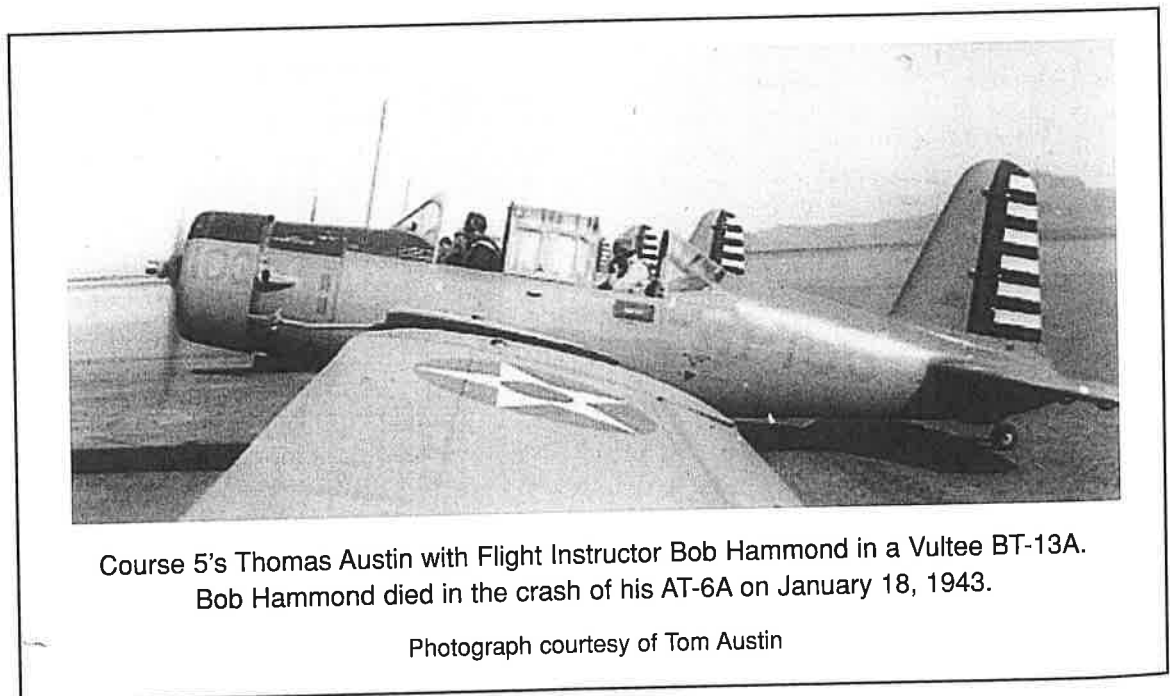

Newly commissioned Pilot Officer Tom Austin and Stirling bombers of 199 Squadron

As a sergeant, Austin served with 199 flying Wellingtons and Stirlings. On the night of May 23, 1943, Austin flew a Wellington X on a bombing mission to Dortmund, Germany. Flying a reciprocal course out of the target area at 13,500 feet, Austin's crew could see the target burning and another bomber at 16,000 to 20,000 feet captured in a searchlight cone. That aircraft was receiving heavy ground fire, and the pilot was doing everything he could to escape the searchlight. Possibly hit, the bomber dived straight down, searchlight following. As the bomber passed Austin, the searchlight locked in on his Wellington. Austin said, "We were coned for a considerable time, and received a hit which forced us to loop and go into a steep dive." The Wellington fell more than 12,000 feet before Austin regained control. Leveling out at 1000 feet, the crew assessed damage. Their aircraft had lost one of its two engines, the hydraulics were out, most gauges did not work, and a large hole had been blown in the deck near the bomb bay. The crew would later learn that the undercarriage would not lock down. Austin crash landed at Mildenhall Air Field in England. All crew survived. Sergeant Gillies, a Falcon classmate, was killed in action on the same Dortmund raid.

For his actions on several missions, especially the Dortmund raid, Austin was awarded the Distinguished Flying Cross. He was commissioned in January 1944. Released in 1946, he joined the restructured RAF Volunteer Reserves (RAFVR) in 1947. He was recalled to active duty during the Korean War, and later served with photographic interpretation and intelligence reserve units in Germany. He retired from the RAFVR on his 60th birthday in 1982. In the year 2000, Tom Austin celebrated the new century by flying with a French pilot in a North American Texan. They did slow rolls over the peaceful French countryside.
